3/20 Previous Minutes:

4/20 Public Forum And Actions To Be Taken:

No members of public in attendance.

5/20 Reports:

- i. Cllr Raper – Ryedale Council have been gathering information on becoming a unitary council with KPMG, alongside seven other local authorities. The North/South divide appears to be the favourite outcome currently, although no final decisions have been made. Final decisions may be put on hold until the Covid-19 pandemic is under control.
- ii. Cllr Sanderson – Expressed her agreement with Cllr Raper. There are savings of between £30million and £80million predicted should the region go to a unitary council. Covid-19 is still a major issue being dealt with by all Councils, particularly in Scarborough.

6/20 Clerks Report:

The Clerk confirmed the location of the grit bins around the village and that NYCC had quoted £90.00 (per bin, two refills). The Caretaker will check the current grit levels, so the Clerk can order refills accordingly.

An email has been received from the Ryedale Resident, regarding the incinerator at Knaption and its proposed increased output. The Councillors were happy that this will have a minimal effect of the Sherburn parish and that no reply be sent.

A new streetlight has been ordered at site SP1 and works should be started within 4 weeks.
